ABOUT JOE RIVERSO AND THE FOUNDATION



Joseph R. Rivero was a beloved and respected White Plains, NY father, son, brother, coach, friend and co-worker whose life was tragically cut short on 9/11. A life-long resident of the city, Joe had stayed close to his roots despite working as a bonds trader for Cantor Fitzgerald in Tower One of the World Trade Center. Having attended Archbishop Stepinac High School where he excelled at football and golf, Joe then became a varsity football coach there for many years while working full-time in NYC. Also

while at Cantor, Joe kept his long-time bartending job at Bob Hyland's Sports Page, where he loved the camaraderie he shared with many friends and patrons. He was a good friend to all and made so many people laugh with his quick wit and wonderful smile.

Joe had always been proud to help his players carry on the traditions in sports that he had come to love as a player himself, where he earned First Team All League honors in 1985 and was a varsity team captain. As a coach, he stressed discipline, a deep sense of community, generosity and a positive attitude, and he strived to develop these traits in his young players. The Foundation was begun by his family and friends to further the activities and

principals Joe espoused during his lifetime by awarding scholarships in his memory.

Since 2002, the Foundation has awarded various scholarships to graduating seniors at Archbishop Stepinac High School via the Joseph R. Rivero Memorial Scholarship and has funded the Lineman Award given to the best lineman on the varsity football team. In 2009, the Foundation also began providing tuition assistance to talented in-coming freshman football players that carry through their four years at Stepinac. The Foundation is a 501(c)(3) organization run by volunteers and is registered with the NY State Attorney General's Charities Bureau. All proceeds go to scholarships and other charitable works.
